## 2018 State Pennant Finals - Locations

Bowls NSW has undertaken greens inspections of all host Clubs for the 2018 State Pennant Finals. This was initiated due to feedback that some host clubs had unforeseen issues arise with their greens.

As a result, 3 sections of the Grade 7 State Pennants have been moved from **Halekulani Bowling Club** to **The Greens The Entrance**.

Halekulani Bowling club greens unfortunately had been affected by an issue, which rendered their greens not up to an acceptable playing standard and a mutual agreement was reached to relocate the event.

The Club will be offered an opportunity to host a Pennant Final in 2019, pending their greens being restored to a suitable playing standard.
